Bible

Poetry

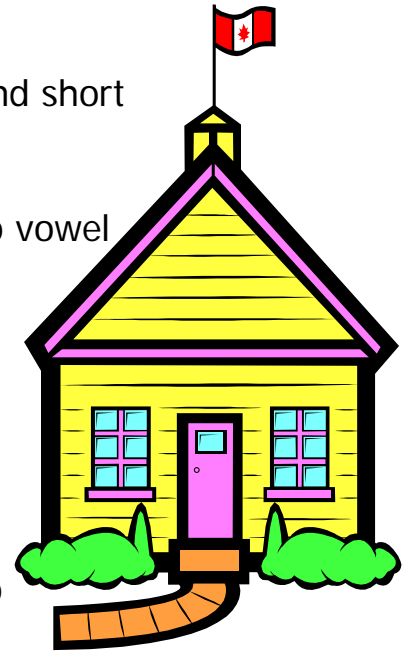
- ❑ Twenty-eight poems and finger plays committed to memory

- ❑ Numbers before and after 1 – 20
- ❑ Numbers largest and smallest 1 – 20
- ❑ Addition facts: 1+1, 2+1, 3+1, 4+1, 5+1, 6+1, 7+1, 8+1, 9+1
