

Northside Christian Academy Middle School Commitment

Our commitment is to be a Christian school that teaches a Biblical worldview. Northside Christian Academy's middle school team has worked together to plan a strategy to teach the whole student.

The following outline will help you see how we integrate this strategy:

A. Character Education

1. Memorizing both definition and verse - Students will have an opportunity to write the definition and verse for a character quality for bonus points in each core class.
2. Recognizing the student who best model's the character quality - We will recognize those students who demonstrate character through the school year.
3. Teaching in chapel about the character quality - One chapel service each month will be devoted to expounding on a character quality.
4. Small Group emphasis on character quality - Small groups will meet each month during the school year and will have a character theme to use as a basis of discussion.

B. Service Project

1. Master's Mission – Students are encouraged to bring a shoebox filled with toys, gloves, etc. to give to orphans in other countries. The middle school spends a day packing the shoeboxes to be shipped.
2. Small group project - Each small group has been challenged to plan and do a service project either after school or on a weekend.
3. Baby Jesus Offering - We will be collecting funds at Christmas to help support a mission's project.
4. Middle School wide project - We will plan a non-school day service project where all of middle school may participate.

C. Integrating the curriculum - We will teach students to relate every academic discipline to God's truth and His self-revelation in Scripture.

D. Critiquing Nonbiblical worldviews - Our students will not be ignorant of the nonbiblical worldviews, such as, Darwinian, because our teachers will be critiquing nonbiblical worldview assumptions.

E. Modeling a Biblical Worldview - Our desire is to model a Biblical Worldview in each of our lives.

Everyone has a worldview (which includes what they believe and why they believe it). We desire our students to have a Biblical Worldview.
