Middle School News

Homecoming Week

September 28-October 2

Students participating in the Spirit Week theme days may wear casual (non-uniform) clothes on each day of Spirit Week. The clothes should coordinate with the designated theme for the day, be appropriate for school, and conform to our dress code with regard to length (**no shorts or mini-skirts for middle school and senior high**), modesty, and not fitting too tightly. Skirt length should be at the knee or longer. Students may **not** wear shorts or boxers on the outside of pants. No sweatpants or wind pants allowed. Students may paint faces on Friday, October 2, ONLY.

Tuesday, September 29 – Decade Day – Dress in clothing from your favorite decade (50s, 60s, 70s, or 80s).

Wednesday, September 30 – Princess & Sportsman's Day - Girls may dress like a princess or girls and boys may dress like their favorite sportsman.

Thursday, October 1 – Western Day – Wear western or “country” apparel.

Friday, October 2 – Red & White/School Spirit– Wear school apparel items with the school’s logo or mascot, or wear red/white/black clothing to demonstrate school spirit.

Master’s Missions

The middle school will participate in the Master’s Mission “JOY” box campaign. Master’s Mission supplies “JOY” boxes (J-Jesus, O-Orphans, Y-You) to orphans in the Ukraine who were affected by the Chernobyl Nuclear Incident. The goal is not only to give a gift to a child who may not receive anything else, but it is also to show them that JESUS loves them! Our goal is to have each student turn in one or more boxes or collect a total of 120. It is an easy and worthwhile project to do. You get a shoebox or small backpack (they can use the backpack after Christmas to carry to school) and fill it with toys

(small cars, dolls, stuffed animals, plastic kazoos, harmonicas, yo-yos, small Etch-A-Sketch, toys that light up or make noise-with extra batteries, slinky, etc.); school supplies (pens, pencils, pencil sharpener, crayons, markers, stamps and ink pads, coloring books, writing pads, piñata, solar calculators, etc.); hygiene items (toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, comb, brush, washcloth, etc) or other items (hard candy, lollipops, mints, gum, sunglasses, flashlights with extra batteries, ball caps, socks, gloves, mittens, toboggans, scarves, t-shirts, toy jewelry, hair clips, watches, small picture books, etc.). As you can see, there are many things from which to choose. Please make sure you label the box *boy* or *girl* and put an age range. They are in need of boxes for teenage children (15-17). If possible, wrap the lid and box separately. They will check the boxes before shipping them. Also, if possible, please include in an envelope \$5.00 (Checks should be made
