Home School Division for High School Students

Northside Christian Academy will permit home school students the opportunity to take up to two academic courses, and no more than three (including one Fine Art) from the Academy at the high school level. These courses consist of the following:

- Advanced Placement Classes (English, US History, Calculus & Biology)
- Honors courses in math and English (as space permits)
- Spanish
- Fine Arts (choir, band, art) – opportunity to participate in the school play

Requirements

1. Home school students will go through testing and interview process
2. Students applying to take courses must meet all school prerequisites
3. Students must abide by NCA dress code standards and abide by school rules
4. Forms Required
 - Recommendation forms (Pastor and Teacher)
 - Copy of the Student's immunization record
 - Copy of the student's birth certificate
 - Copy of the student's latest report card
 - Copy of student's latest achievement/aptitude test scores
