### Notes:

1. Classes for juniors and seniors end on Friday, May 14, 2010. Their exams begin on Monday the 17<sup>th</sup>.
2. Exemption for juniors and seniors will be determined by semester averages as of Friday, May 14, 2010.
  - a. Juniors who have a 95 semester average or above, no more than 7 absences from the class during second semester, and no outstanding fees or fines may be exempt from the exam.
  - b. Seniors who have a 90 semester average or above, no more than 7 absences from the class during second semester, and no outstanding fees or fines may be exempt from the exam.
  - c. Students in AP classes may exempt the second semester exam by scoring a 4 or higher on the practice exam closest to the actual AP exam for the course, having no more than 7 absences from the class during second semester, and having no outstanding fees or fines.
3. All juniors and seniors will take their exams in the library. The third period study hall that normally meets in the library will report to Mr. Riddell's room.
4. Juniors and seniors may be off campus when they do not have an exam. If they are on campus, they must report to study hall.
5. All textbooks must be returned prior to taking an exam or in order to be exempt from an exam.
